Through the grassroots efforts of Koins, utilizing volunteer help from the US and labor forces of the villages we serve, we are able to complete projects at a fraction of what it would cost to provide similar items in the US. Koins requires local communities to be highly mobilized, providing at least 10% of all necessary project funds, and all of the unskilled labor through villager participation. By doing this we create a community invested in their future, working together for the betterment of all. We avoid creating dependency or the welfare mentality that a free handout instills.

The goal of Koins for Kenya is to develop programs which are self-sustaining, lasting long after our departure for other villages.

Every year around Christmas, we begin the same routine: finding the perfect gift for those we love, and deciding what that would be for ourselves. In the midst of shopping, final exams and end of year parties and celebrations, it is easy to get caught up in the excitement and forget what Christmas is really about.

After every expedition to Kenya, we are reminded of the blessings we have and how the little we give can go so far in rural Kenya.

It is in this spirit that Koins for Kenya has developed the Gift of Hope program. You can contribute funds towards a program of your choice, as a gift to a loved one or as a gift from you. You do not have to fly to Kenya to give this life changing gift. These gifts have been created based on the needs of the people and communities where Koins operates. The recipients are people ready to improve their lives, but need a little help from you. By purchasing a gift for them you are providing opportunities for a better life. This is one gift you give that will never rust, be forgotten or grow too small.



ROTATIONAL GARDENS \$200

Rotational gardens are *one-time sponsorships. The \$200 donation provides your sponsored family, of whom you will become familiar, with everything they need to create the garden that will provide their children with the nutrition they need for brain, muscle and bone development. The rotational garden sponsorship provides all the seed, soil treatments, insect repellent, water and protective fencing from goats, chickens and curious little people.



BORE HOLE WELL \$4,000

Bore holes will provide the best, long-term return for our dollars spent on water. For \$4,000 we can drill a borehole deep into Kenya's aquifer. One borehole can provide water for an entire village, ending sickness and even death from lack of water.

PERPETUAL CHICKEN PROGRAM \$250

This is another *one-time sponsorship. Since farmers have very little or no extra money, participation in this program can be difficult because of our requirements for housing, flock health and initial feeding of the chickens. The sponsorship provides the initial chickens, housing for the birds, vaccinations against avian illnesses, and a feeding/ watering start-up kit.



MILK GOAT PROGRAM \$200

Milk goat sponsorship will add one goat to the Koins herd. A one time donation of \$200 purchases the goat, all vaccinations and feed seed for the life of the animal. The babies who benefit from the milk of these goats will fill our classrooms in the future.



WATER CISTERN \$3,500

Water cisterns are a practical way to catch the rain water coming off the tin roofs of our school buildings. A cistern provides a fresh source of water for the needs of students in our schools year round.

STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

\$400 - Students who excel in the classroom need not be held back because their families do not have the capacity to pay school fees. These fees are required for tuition, uniforms and books, but are the equivalent of a year's salary for many villagers.

\$2,500 - The superstars who qualify for university (less than 2% of our village students) are those who will make the most impact on this rural area in the future. A village family has no way to pay the cost of a university education for their children.



CLASSROOM BUILDING \$9,000

A classroom building that can hold up to 100 students, built with block construction, a tin roof and cement floor costs \$9,000.
